All chosen Teen Volunteers will be required to attend a mandatory training May 26 from 4:00-5:30 pm. This training cannot be missed as we will be discussing expectations, duties, events, schedules, WML Policy (including COVID-19 precautions/protocol).

This is a great opportunity for you to have fun with children, be a mentor and gain work experience.

Your volunteer time will be a valuable addition for future job applications or scholarships.

A letter of recommendation will be available upon your request.

Another bonus is a free T-shirt which serves as your required uniform.
