- **May 29, 4:30-6 pm:** **Mandatory Training for chosen applicants** (only 16 teens will be chosen) This training cannot be missed as we will be discussing expectations, duties, events, schedules, and WML Policy.

This is a great opportunity to gain work experience while having fun. Your volunteer time will be a valuable addition for future job applications or scholarships. A letter of recommendation will be available upon your request. Another bonus is a free T-shirt which serves as your required uniform.

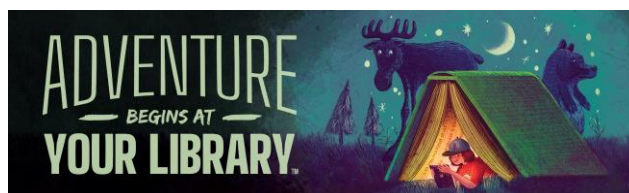
The 2024 SRP Teen Volunteer Team is absolutely necessary for the success of the Summer Reading Program. Your service is greatly appreciated!
